



Single-switch heating system Munich South Germany

At the former Munich South railway station, the Single-switch heating system was extensively modernised.

As part of the project, the existing sheet metal control boxes were dismantled and replaced with new points heating control units housed in concrete control cabinets. In addition, the points equipment, junction boxes and cabling for a total of 56 sets of points were replaced.

Despite three major construction projects taking place simultaneously on the site, the renewal of the electric point heating system was successfully completed on schedule.
