



Munich Central Station – 3 projects Germany

Location: Germany

Construction period: 2020–2022
Services: Installation of new points heating systems; cable laying, including underground cable works
Contract value: 3.2 million euros



Following three successfully completed projects at Munich Central Station, we were once again able to impress the client with the high quality of our work.

As part of these three projects, a total of 9 concrete formwork houses were erected, 152 sets of points were connected and around 35 km of cable, including underground cable installation, was laid.

Despite the site-specific challenges – due to the low height of the overhead lines – the project was successfully completed.

As it was not possible to use a track crane, the concrete formwork houses were erected precisely and efficiently using two road-rail excavators.

A particular highlight of the project was the design of a concrete switch box under the motto 'A different take on the concrete switch box'. To this end, DB commissioned a well-known graffiti artist from Munich, who enhanced the appearance of the technical structure with his creative design, turning it into a real eye-catcher.

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
