



Refurbishment of the Wipkingen Tunnel – General Contractor Tunnel Zurich, Switzerland

The “Wipkingen Tunnel Refurbishment” project comprised the rehabilitation and modernization of the historic railway tunnel in Zurich. It was originally excavated using mining methods in 1856. The tunnel was refurbished in 1986 and 1989, and a covered section was constructed on the Wipkingen side. The project described here involved the refurbishment of this structure.

The main tasks included:

- ✓ Tunnel vault refurbishment
- ✓ Track renewal
- ✓ Cable systems
- ✓ Temporary works
- ✓ Other general services, such as rail logistics, environmental measures, surveying and monitoring services, etc.

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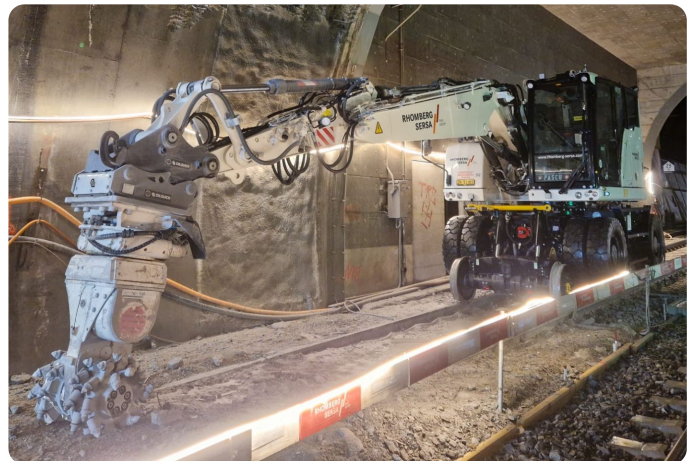
The project was divided into two construction phases: the “vault refurbishment” phase, carried out in 2023, and the “track” phase in 2024. Works on the vault were executed track-bound during short night closures. Track refurbishment was carried out during a continuous single-track closure with nightly operating breaks on the respective operational track.
